### RAINIERS NOTES

**Triumphant Return:** INF Oswaldo Navarro has been added to the roster of the Tacoma Rainiers from the roster of the West Tennessee Diamond Jaxx (AA Southern League). Navarro spent 104 games with the Rainiers in 2008 and batted .261/.326/.333 (93x357) with 21 doubles, one triple, one home run, 47 runs, and 31 RBI. Navarro played 2B, 3B, and SS in 2008.

**Morse traded for Langerhans:** INF Mike Morse was traded to the Washington Nationals in exchange for 1B/OF Ryan Langerhans. Morse batted .312/.370/.481 (81x260) in 66 games for the Rainiers this season, including 14 doubles, 10 home runs, 38 runs, and 52 RBI while playing 2B, 3B, and SS. Morse spent 107 with the Mariners from 2005-2008. Langerhans batted .278/.371/.488 (57x205) in 64 games for the Syracuse Chiefs (AAA International League), including 16 doubles, nine home runs, 34 runs, and 50 RBI. Langerhans appeared in 474 MLB games from 2002-2008 with the Braves, Athletics, and Nationals.

**Breaking Out:** Prior to last night's offensive explosion (3x4 with a double and a home run), OF Michael Saunders had batted .107 (3x28) with nine strikeouts in his first eight games versus Reno.

**It's a Game of Inches:** The Rainiers have lost two consecutive games by one run apiece (5-6 and 3-4) despite out hitting the Aces in both contests (10-9 and 10-8).

**That's Not a Typo:** The High Desert Mavericks scored 18 runs last night, but still lost to the Lake Elsinore Storm by a score of 18-33. There were a combined 58 hits, including 18 doubles, 3 triples, and 10 home runs. C Jose Yopez hit a home run in the fourth inning and later "pitched" .1 inning, which resulted in five hits, five runs (all earned), and four home runs. Yopez left the game with an ERA of 135.00. To add further insult to injury, the Mavericks committed five errors.

**Streaking:** First baseman Brad Nelson is in possession of a young six-game hit streak. Nelson is batting .391 (9x23) over his last six games, including eight singles and one home run. Nelson has scored only two runs and two RBI over the six-game period.

**Missing Comrades:** First baseman Mike Carp and shortstop Chris Woodward have both been added to the Seattle Mariners since the first series versus Reno. Both batters were a combined .391 (9x23) with three doubles, one home run, five runs, and four RBI in four games versus Reno this season.

**The New Doubles King:** Outfielder Bryan LaHair matched the Tacoma franchise mark of 94 doubles set by Dan Rohrmeier on 6/27. Catcher Jeff Clement ranks third in Tacoma history with 84 doubles.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered another tough luck loss, a 1-4 defeat vs. Las Vegas on 6/24...pitched 6.0 IP and allowed only two runs (both earned)...surrendered seven hits, including three doubles and one triple...walked three, struck out three...induced eight ground outs and seven fly outs...faced 26 batters...threw 97 pitches and 58 strikes

**VERSUS THE BEAVERS:** This is Seddon's first 2009 outing versus the Beavers.

**2009:** Has been outstanding at Cheney Stadium: 3-2 with a 3.57 ERA and a .225 opponents' batting average...monthly ERA has improved every month this season (6.86 in April; 4.26 in May; and 3.33 thus far in June)...earned three wins in consecutive outings (5/25 vs. NAS, 5/30 at COL, and 6/4 vs. REN)...allowed only one earned run in those three wins...last road win was 5/30 at COL...has allowed only nine earned runs over his last six starts, dating back to 5/25 vs. NAS.

**2008:** Recorded a career-high 10 wins at Albuquerque (AAA)...pitched the Isotopes' first complete game of the season; 6/1 versus Memphis (9IP, 6H, 1R, 3BB, 8K)...also recorded his first career hit in that game...struck out a season-high nine batters over six innings on 5/27 versus Nashville...pitched his second complete game of the season in the first game of a doubleheader on 6/18 at Memphis...selected to the PCL All Star Game...ranked fifth in the PCL with 126 strikeouts.

**PERSONAL:** Christopher John Seddon...born 10/13/83 in Northridge, CA...graduated from Canyon High School (CA) in 2001...offered a full scholarship to play baseball at Loyola Marymount University (CA) but signed with the Devil Rays...played in the 15th annual Goodwill Series with Delmon Young and Scott Kazmir in 2000.
