RAINIERS NOTES

Gaining Momentum: The Rainiers are 5-0 on the road this month after sweeping the Express at Round Rock and winning the series opener at Albuquerque last night. That active five-game win streak is the longest of the season for the Rainiers. The Rainiers offense has batted .260 (45x173) with seven doubles and six home runs over those five games, while the Rainiers arms have earned a 2.60 ERA (13 ER/45.0 IP) amid 33 strikeouts and only four walks.

Moving Up the Charts: The Rainiers have gained 2.5 games in divisional standings (from 7.0 to 4.5 games back) over its current five-game win streak. The Rainiers have not been this close to the Pacific North division lead since they were 4.0 games back on 6/18.

Trailblazing: Leadoff man Jerry Owens has batted .500 (6x12) with one home run, four runs, two RBI, and two stolen bases over his current three-game hit streak. Owens has batted .400 (12x30) in eight August contests. Owens has collected a hit in seven of those eight games and multiple hits in five of those eight games.

Contact Machine: Josh Wilson has batted .263 (5x19) with three runs and one RBI over his current five-game hit streak. Wilson has collected zero walks and only one strikeout over those five games. Wilson has batted .350 (7x20) with the bases empty this season for the Rainiers.

Coming Alive: Alex Cintrón has batted .368 (7x19) over his current five-game hit streak. Cintrón has batted .367 (11x30) in 11 road games with the Rainiers this season.

Security Blanket: Right-handed pitcher Randy Messenger has earned a save in each of his last three games. Messenger has converted 24 of 27 save opportunities this season, including every opportunity since 7/1 (11x11) and eight saves in July. Messenger ranks tied for the league lead in saves with 24, and Messenger ranks ninth in Tacoma career saves with 25. Jim Corsi owns the Tacoma career record in saves with 36.

Running Wild: Brad Nelson has both reached base safely and scored a run in each of his last four games. Nelson has batted .235 (4x17) with one home run, four runs, and one RBI over that four-game stretch. Nelson's bat has become more potent throughout the summer as he hit one home run in May (nine games), two in June (19 games), seven in July (20 games), and two thus far in August (nine games).

None Shall Pass: Right-handed pitcher Jared Wells has been nearly untouchable since returning to action from the disabled list on 7/27. Wells has tabulated a 1.59 ERA (1 ER/5.2 IP) in five appearances since his recovery. More importantly, Wells has allowed only one hit in those five appearance, which equals a scanty .059 opponents' batting average.

ACQUIRED: Traded to Seattle by Philadelphia with Andrew Barb (RHP) in exchange for Jamie Moyer (LHP) on 8/20/06...drafted by Philadelphia in the fifth round (152nd overall selection) of the 2004 draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Won his sixth game of the season in a complete game shutout at Round Rock on 8/5...threw 116 pitches and 83 strikes to 33 batters over 9.0 innings...allowed six hits, including one double...walked none and struck out six...induced nine ground outs and 12 fly outs...was the second complete game shutout Baldwin has pitched versus Round Rock (7/31/08 and 8/5/09).

VERSUS THE ISOTOPES: This is Baldwin's first 2009 outing versus the Isotopes.

2009: Opened season by earning win with 6.0 IP of shutout baseball 4/13 at FRE...went 2-1 with a 1.66 ERA (4 ER/21.2 IP), .195 batting average, zero home runs, and 17 strikeouts in April...started 19 and relieved four games...went five appearances without a decision (from 7/16 to 7/30)...leads the Rainiers in innings pitched (127.2)...only Tacoma pitcher to throw complete game shutout this season (8/5 at RR).

2008: Spent entire season with Tacoma (AAA)...named "King of the Hill" by the Rainiers as the club's best pitcher...led all Mariners farmhands with a career-high 10 wins...struck out a season-high 8 batters in 7.0 innings on May 28 at Fresno...won 4 consecutive starts, June 19-July 5, allowing only 7 earned run in 28.0 innings (2.25 ERA)...also had 4-game win streak, July 31-Aug. 25...limited right-handed batters to a .240 average (69x287), compared to a .344 average (108x314) vs. left-handed batters.

PERSONAL: Andrew Scott Baldwin...born October 20, 1982 in Duluth, MN... resides in Portland, Oregon...graduated from Hood River Valley High School (OR) in 2000...attended Oregon State University...uncle John Hiller was a left-handed relief pitcher for DET (1965-70, 1972-80)...is an avid golfer...has yet to make his MLB debut.
