RAINIERS NOTES

Closing In: The Rainiers are now tied with the Salt Lake Bees for second place in the Pacific North division. The Rainiers have not placed better than third in the division since 4/20. The Rainiers end their season with two pivotal series versus division foes as they host Salt Lake Bees from 8/31 to 9/3 and Colorado Springs Sky Sox from 9/4 to 9/7.

Finish What You Start: Brandon Morrow's complete game shutout last night was the second this month by a Rainiers pitcher. Right-handed pitcher Andy Baldwin (starting tomorrow) threw a complete game shutout at Round Rock on 8/5. Baldwin walked none and struck out six in the 8-0 victory. Baldwin earned PCL Pitcher of the Week for that performance.

Show of Force: The Rainiers are 7-2 (.778) versus the American North division. The Rainiers have outscored American North opponents 64-42 over those nine contests.

Left to Their Own Devices: The Rainiers have been tough on left-handed pitching this season. Adam Moore, Jerry Owens, and Chris Shelton all sport batting averages of .325 or better versus southpaws. Moore has batted .338 (25x74), with nine of those 25 hits going for extra bases (eight doubles and one home run). Owens has registered a .346 batting average (18x52) and .404 on base percentage to couple with his eight runs and eight RBI. Shelton has batted .338 (24x69) with four doubles, one triple, two home runs, and 14 RBI.

Safe Haven: Brad Nelson has both reached base safely each of his last seven games. Nelson has batted .222 (6x27) with one triple, one home run, seven runs, one RBI, and three walks over that seven-game stretch. Nelson has scored a run in six of those seven games.

Rock Solid: Matt Tuiasosopo has batted .353 (6x17) with one double, two home runs, six runs, and five RBI over his current five-game hit streak. Tuiasosopo leads the PCL in August with 19 RBI. Tuiasosopo has batted .298/.398/.548 (31x104) with eight doubles, six home runs, 19 runs, and 24 RBI in 27 games since returning to the Rainiers from the disabled list.

Top of the Stops: Right-handed pitcher Randy Messenger has converted 24 of 27 save opportunities this season, including every opportunity since 7/1 (11x11) and eight saves in July. Messenger ranks second in the PCL in with 24 saves. Messenger also ranks ninth in Tacoma career saves with 25. Jim Corsi owns the Tacoma career record in saves with 36.

None Shall Pass: Right-handed pitcher Jared Wells has been nearly untouchable since returning to action from the disabled list on 7/27. Wells has tabulated a 1.35 ERA (1 ER/6.2 IP) in six appearances since his recovery. More importantly, Wells has allowed only two hits in those six appearances, which equals a scanty .095 opponents' batting average.

ACQUIRED: Signed a minor league contract with the Seattle Mariners in December 2008...selected off waivers by the Florida Marlins from the Tampa Bay Devil Rays in June 2007...drafted by the Tampa Bay Devil Rays in the fifth round of the 2001 draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned no decision in a 6-4 victory at Albuquerque on 8/9...threw 94 pitches and 56 strikes to 26 batters over 6.0 innings...allowed six hits, including two doubles and one triple, and four earned runs...walked three, struck out two, picked off one (at first base), balked twice, and threw two wild pitches.

VERSUS THE CUBS: This is Seddon's first 2009 outing versus the Cubs.

2009: Earned 2-0 record and 0.82 ERA (1 ER/11.0 IP) in first two starts returned from the disabled list (sprained ankle) on 7/25... allowed four or more earned runs only twice since 5/25; 13 appearances...monthly ERA improved each month (6.86 in April; 4.26 in May; 3.52 in June; and 2.11 in July)...was beneficiary of five double plays in June after receiving only one through April and May...earned three consecutive wins this season...allowed only four total earned runs over those two three-win streaks...opponents' batting average dropped three consecutive months (.265 in June; .253 in July; and .214 in August).

2008: Recorded a career-high 10 wins at Albuquerque (AAA)...pitched the Isotopes' first complete game of the season; 6/1 versus Memphis (9IP, 6H, 1R, 3BB, 8K)...also recorded his first career hit in that game...struck out a season-high nine batters over six innings on 5/27 versus Nashville...pitched his second complete game of the season in the first game of a doubleheader on 6/18 at Memphis...selected to the PCL All Star Game...ranked fifth in the PCL with 126 strikeouts.

PERSONAL: Christopher John Seddon...born 10/13/83 in Northridge, CA...graduated from Canyon High School (CA) in 2001...offered a scholarship to play baseball at Loyola Marymount University (CA) but signed with the Devil Rays...played in the 15th annual Goodwill Series with Delmon Young and Scott Kazmir in 2000.
