RAINIERS NOTES

Returning Southpaw: Left-handed pitcher Garrett Olson has been optioned to AAA Tacoma. Olson went 2-2 with a 3.08 ERA (9 ER/26.1 IP) in five starts with Tacoma this season. Olson went 3-5 with a 5.88 ERA (49 ER/75.0 IP), 32 walks, and 45 strikeouts in 24 games, 11 starts, with Seattle this season.

Spread it Around: Last night marked the 10th game this season in which each Rainiers batter registered at least one hit. The previous nine contests were 4/24 vs. SLK, 5/7 at SLK, 5/15 at NEW, 6/6 at LAS, 6/15 at POR, 6/23 vs. LAS, 6/29 at REN, 7/22 vs. SAC, and 7/26 vs. LAS. The Rainiers outscored their opponents 101 to 35 in those 10 games. The Rainiers are 9-1 in those 10 games with the lone loss occurring in a 7-8 defeat at Reno on 6/29.

Field Artillery: Last night marked the first time this season the Rainiers have hit three home runs in one inning. The back-to-back home runs hit by Mike Wilson (his first AAA home run) and Adam Moore represented the seventh pair of back-to-back home runs hit by the Rainiers this season. Chris Shelton became the eighth Rainiers batter to hit two home runs in the same game. Bryan LaHair and Prentice Redman have each doubled up three times this season. The Rainiers lead the PCL in home runs (145) and have scored 221 runs via long ball this season.

Return to Form: Mike Carp has reached base safely in each of his last eight games and has recorded a hit in each of his last six games. Carp has batted .368 (9x24) with one triple, two home runs, three runs, and three RBI over that six-game hit streak. Carp has earned a .708 slugging percentage and claimed 17 total bases over that six-game hit streak.

Late Season Reinforcement: Chris Shelton has batted .429 (9x21) with five runs and six RBI over his current six-game hit streak. Shelton has batted .353/.463/.559 (12x34) with one double, two home runs, seven runs, nine RBI, seven walks, and only two strikeouts in 10 games since rejoining the Rainiers (from Seattle) on 8/9.

Big Fella, Small Streak: Brad Nelson has registered a hit in each of his last three games. Nelson has batted .400 (4x10) with two home runs, two runs, and seven RBI over that span. Nelson has hit twice as many home runs (14) as he has doubles (7) with the Rainiers this season.

Finish What You Start: Randy Messenger has closed in on the Tacoma single season record for saves. Messenger has 25 saves this season, which ranks third among Tacoma single season performances. Todd Williams recorded 32 saves for the Rainiers in 2000, and Joe Bitker recorded 29 saves for the Tacoma Tigers in 1990. Messenger ranks second in the PCL in saves, behind Albuquerque's Brian Strickland (27). Messenger's teammate, Jared Wells, led the PCL in saves in 2008 with 20.

Bet On It: The Rainiers are 12-6 on Thursdays and 9-5 versus teams from the American North division.

ACQUIRED: Signed a minor league contract with the Seattle Mariners in December 2008...selected off waivers by the Florida Marlins from the Tampa Bay Devil Rays in June 2007...drafted by the Tampa Bay Devil Rays in the fifth round of the 2001 draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered seventh loss of the season in a 4-7 defeat versus Iowa on 8/15...threw 97 pitches and 65 strikes to 26 batters over 5.0 innings...allowed six runs and five earned runs – most earned runs since 5/18...surrendered eight hits, including four doubles – three of those doubles hit by Luis Rivas...walked two and struck out three...threw one wild pitch...induced three ground outs and nine fly outs.

VERSUS THE ROYAL: This is Seddon's first 2009 outing versus the Royals.

2009: Earned 2-0 record and 0.82 ERA (1 ER/11.0 IP) in first two starts returned from the disabled list (sprained ankle) on 7/25... allowed four or more earned runs only thrice since 5/25; 14 appearances...monthly ERA improved each month (6.86 in April; 4.26 in May; 3.52 in June; and 2.11 in July)...was beneficiary of five double plays in June after receiving only one through April and May...earned three consecutive wins twice this season...allowed only four total earned runs over those two three-win streaks...has held opponents to a sub-.270 batting average every month since April: .247 in May, .265 in June, .253 in July, and .258 in August.

2008: Recorded a career-high 10 wins at Albuquerque (AAA)...pitched the Isotopes' first complete game of the season; 6/1 versus Memphis (9IP, 6H, 1R, 3BB, 8K)...also recorded his first career hit in that game...struck out a season-high nine batters over six innings on 5/27 versus Nashville...pitched his second complete game of the season in the first game of a doubleheader on 6/18 at Memphis...selected to the PCL All Star Game...ranked fifth in the PCL with 126 strikeouts.

PERSONAL: Christopher John Seddon...born 10/13/83 in Northridge, CA...graduated from Canyon High School (CA) in 2001...offered a scholarship to play baseball at Loyola Marymount University (CA) but signed with the Devil Rays...played in the 15th annual Goodwill Series with Delmon Young and Scott Kazmir in 2000.
