### RAINIERS NOTES

**Fister Selected:** The Seattle Mariners selected right handed-pitcher Doug Fister from AAA Tacoma. Fister will wear #58 and be making his Major League debut when he appears for the Mariners. Fister, 25, compiled a 6-4 record with a 3.81 ERA (45 ER/106.1 IP) in 22 appearance and 17 starts with Tacoma this season. Most impressively, Fister walked only 11 batters and struck out 79. Fister was originally selected by the Mariners in the 7th round of the 2006 draft out of Fresno State University.

**Vargas Optioned:** The Seattle Mariners also optioned left-handed pitcher Jason Vargas to AAA Tacoma. Vargas, 26, was 3-6 with a 5.08 ERA in 16 appearances (14 starts) with the Mariners this season. Vargas is 1-2 with a 2.93 ERA (9 ER/27.2 IP) over five starts and two stints with the Rainiers this season.

**Every Streak Starts Small:** Brad Nelson and Alex Cintrón are both in possession of burgeoning three-game hit streaks. Nelson has batted .286 (4x14) with one home run, three runs, and one RBI over his last three games. Cintrón has batted .273 (3x11) over his last three games and .318 (7x22) on the road this season.

**Duck Hunt:** Third baseman Matt Tuiasosopo has batted .522 (12x23) over his current six-game hit streak, which includes one double, three home runs, four runs, and 14 RBI. Tuiasosopo has driven in at least one run in each of those six games. The Rainiers are 5-1 in those six games.

**None Shall Pass:** Right-handed pitcher Jared Wells has been nearly untouchable since returning to action from the disabled list on 7/27. Wells has tabulated a 1.59 ERA (1 ER/5.2 IP) in five appearances since his recovery. More importantly, Wells has allowed only one hit in those five appearance, which equals a scanty .059 opponents' batting average.

**Road Warriors:** Tacoma has an opportunity tonight to set a new season high in consecutive victories away from Cheney Stadium. The current three-game road win streak equals the longest this season (from 5/15 to 5/17 at New Orleans and Oklahoma City). Additionally, the Rainiers have not swept an opponent this season. Tacoma has not lost a game to Round Rock since 5/17/07.

**Century Club:** The Rainiers have committed 100 errors (50 at home and 50 on the road) and turned 100 double plays (52 at home and 48 on the road) this season. The Rainiers snapped a season-high errorless streak of six games (from 8/2 to 8/7) last night. The Rainiers' second-longest errorless streak (five games) occurred 7/27 to 7/31.

**Ginger Hammer:** Chris Shelton has batted .343 (61x178) with 13 doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 32 runs, and 39 RBI over 43 road contests this season. Those batting average, hits, and RBI totals represent team highs.

**ACQUIRED:** Drafted by the Seattle Mariners in the first round – fifth overall selection – in the 2006 draft...selected by the Anaheim Angels in the 40th round (1200th overall) in the 2003 draft

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned his first AAA win of the season in a 7-2 victory versus Fresno on 8/3...needed only 89 pitches and 62 strikes (69.6% strike rate) to work through 28 batters over 7.0 innings...allowed seven hits, including four doubles and one home run, and two earned runs...walked one and struck out five...threw one wild pitch...induced four ground outs and 11 fly outs.

**VERSUS THE EXPRESS:** This is Morrow's first 2009 outing versus the Express.

**2009:** Started 2009 with the Seattle Mariners...made 22 appearances and six starts...accumulated an 0-4 record with six saves in eight opportunities with Seattle...5.28 ERA (27 ER/46.0 IP) with Seattle, including 31 walks and 45 strikeouts...saved four consecutive games from 4/17 to 5/10...converted to rotation on 6/13...went 0-1 with a 4.55 ERA (14 ER/27.2 IP) as a starter for Seattle...greatly favors the confines of Cheney Stadium: 2.31 ERA (3 ER/11.2 IP) at home and 12.00 ERA (12 ER/9.0 IP) on road.

**2008:** Made 45 appearances and five starts for Seattle...went 3-4 with 10 saves and a 3.34 ERA (24 ER/64.2 IP)...earned a 1.47 ERA (6 ER/36.2 IP) as a reliever...that relief ERA ranked second-lowest in Seattle Mariners history, trailing only RHP J.J. Putz (1.38 in 2007)...made first Major League start in 101st appearance, 9/5 vs. New York...allowed one hit, one run and struck out 9 in 7.2 innings...no-hit the Yankees through 7.2 innings...earned first career save 6/11 at Toronto...was 8x8 in save opportunities to open the season...optioned to Tacoma (AAA) on 8/5 to begin transition to starting pitcher...made 5 starts for the Rainiers, going 1-1 with a 3.37 ERA (7 ER/18.2 IP)...opened the season at West Tennessee (AA).

**PERSONAL:** Brandon John Morrow...attended Rancho Cotate High School in Rohnert Park, California and University of California Berkeley in Berkeley, CA...diagnosed as a Type 1 diabetic his senior year of high school...wears an insulin pump to regulate blood sugar levels.
